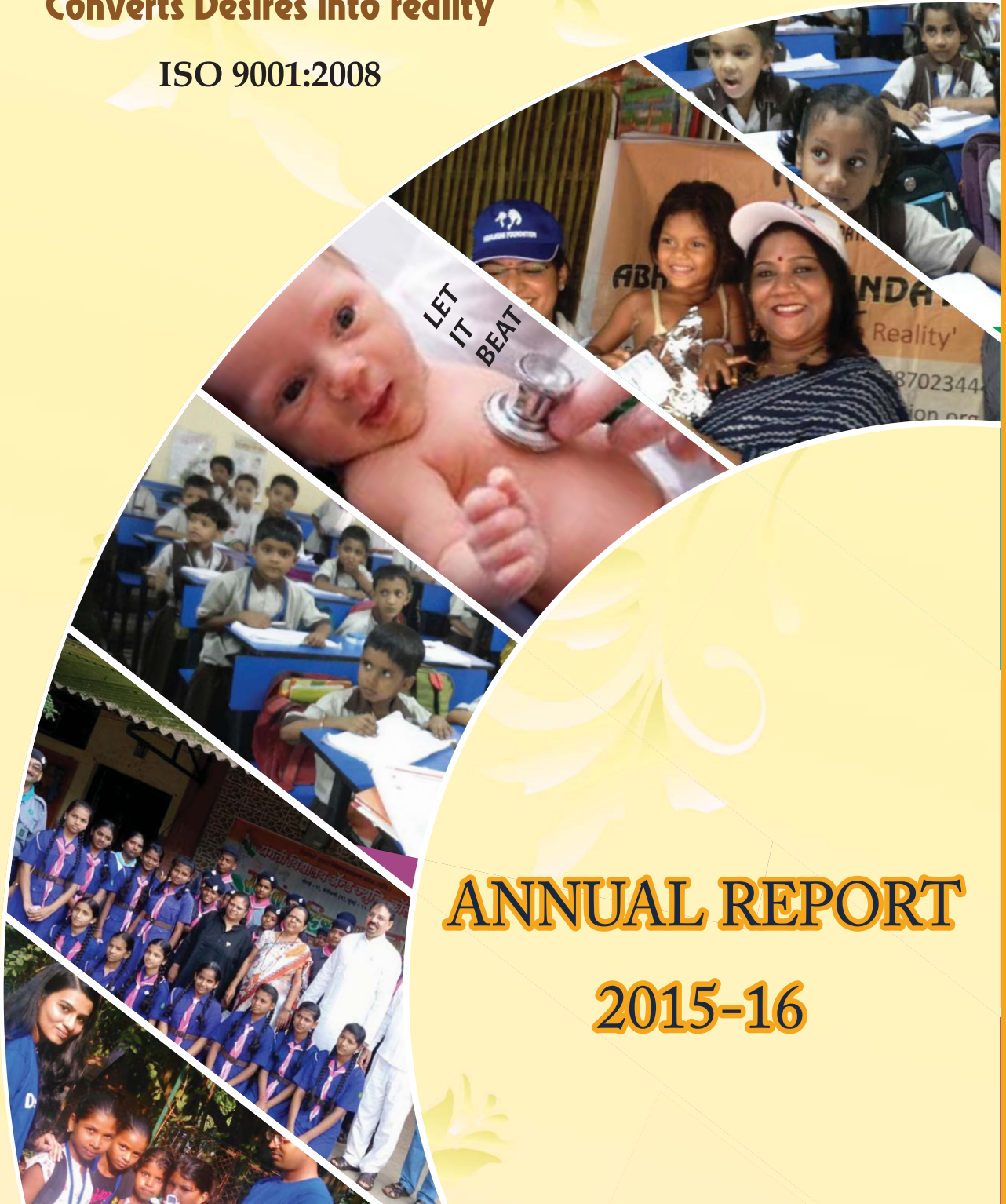

Milestones & Achievements



- ❖ Balwadi and Day Care Centre in Gorai III, Borivali, Mumbai imparting education for more than 65 underprivileged children.
- ❖ Balwadi and Day Care Centre in Kalyan imparting education for more than 45 Brick Kiln workers children
- ❖ Adopted Pragati Vidyalaya & Junior College of Arts and Commerce imparting education for more than 900 slum children and placed portable classroom for E-Learning for the underprivileged children. We also painted and repaired the classrooms and roofs.
- ❖ Balwadi and Day Care Centre in Ambuj Wadi, Malad, Mumbai imparting education for more than 150 underprivileged children.
- ❖ Diamond Girls Pre-Primary and Primary School, Malegaon District, Nasik, Maharashtra imparting education for 1200 underprivileged girls. Constructed 10 toilets and drinking water tanks in the school and implemented "Swach Bharat Abhiyan". We also distributed "Poshtik Aahar" to the girls.
- ❖ Navshiyacha Adivasi Pada, Goregaon Abhilasha Foundation distributed Poshtik Aahar for more than 350 tribal children who are affected with malnutrition.
- ❖ Scholarship provided for more than 25 underprivileged children for their education.
- ❖ Holistic development for 25 orphan and semi orphan girls.
- ❖ Voluntarily working with various renowned hospitals in Mumbai to fund for critical medical surgeries for Below Poverty Line Children. We have supported more than 50 underprivileged children for their Open Heart critical surgeries.
- ❖ Conducted medical camps in schools, Balwadi's and community for more than 1000 BPL families.
- ❖ Supporting 48 senior citizens for their holistic development.
- ❖ Empowering over 100 women by imparting them with various training programmes like mattress making, leather bag making, beauty parlour, gift packing etc.
- ❖ Supported Chennai flood victims for more than 100 families by distributing them with medicines and food etc.
- ❖ We celebrate all festivals with the underprivileged children. We also attend various exhibitions for promoting the activities conducted by the organization.
- ❖ Conducted Health awareness campaign, World Heart Day, Tree Plantation, Counseling adolescent girls for their health and hygiene.

Our Impact:

- ❖ We reached more than 4058 direct beneficiaries including women and children in 2015-16 better educated for life and protected from malnutrition.
- ❖ Financially supported more than 50 underprivileged children for their critical medical surgeries.
- ❖ More than 2460 are better educated for life.



OUR PROJECTS & PROGRAMMES

Educational Support: "Education is a key to unlock the Golden door of freedom. It's an endless journey through knowledge and enlightenment"- Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam

Our aim is to contribute measurably and help children enjoy their childhood, good health, be educated, be cared and protected, and participate fully in decisions that affect their lives. Abhilasha Foundation ensures quality education in English for these underprivileged children that helps them to attain fluency in English language.

Our Projects :



Balwadi & Day Care Centre in Gorai 3, Borivali: Abhilasha Foundation is imparting education in Gorai 3 for more than 65 tribal and migrant children by providing them elementary education. The parents are mostly rag pickers, maions, painters, carpenters, and the women are mostly domestic servants. The men are mostly alcoholic. There is a drastic improvement in the reading, writing and learning levels of these underprivileged children.

Balwadi & Day Care Centre in Haji Malangad, Kalyan: The second portable classroom is being placed with Bahujan Hitay Trust, Kalyan for more than 45 Brick Kiln workers children in Kalyan. The children live in a very deplorable condition they are also deprived of the basic amenities like drinking water, basic sanitation, adequate nutrition, clean environment and primary education. These children were also taken for exposure visits like Kidzania, Nehru Planetarium etc.



Balwadi and Day Care Centre at Ambujwadi-Malad: Abhilasha Foundation inaugurated the third Balwadia and Day Care Centre. More than 500 underprivileged children who are migrants from various parts of India are imparting education in this Balwadi. More than 50 children were school drop outs and parents were counseled and admitted them back to school. Abhilasha Foundation focuses mainly on English language for which they face difficulty.



Diamond Girls Pre-Primary & Primary School at Malegaon (Nasik): Abhilasha Foundation adopted this school which is imparting education for more than 1200 children to provide free education for girls from slum community for their holistic development. The parents of these children work in the power loom factories as labourers. Abhilasha Foundation is also providing infrastructure, better learning facilities and safety to the underprivileged children. It is our first responsibility to nurture their talent and their health and provide them with good education to these underprivileged children. Abhilasha Foundation helped these underprivileged children to unlock their potential and realize their dreams.



Pragati Vidyalaya & Junior College of Arts and Commerce, Gorai 2, Borivali (West): Abhilasha Foundation has adopted the school for imparting education for more than 900 underprivileged children. The children belong to below poverty line and their families are staying in the slum without any basic amenities. Abhilasha Foundation is assisting the school management to install E-Learning classes and aim to make one of the best digitalized school in Borivali area.

Medical Support Programme: Abhilasha Foundation provides financial medical support for children belonging to below poverty line, minorities and backward communities. All the cases are referred by various renowned hospitals. We work voluntarily with Sir H N Reliance Foundation Hospital and Research Centre, P D Hinduja Hospital, Seven Hills Hospital, Kokilaben Ambani Hospital, Wadia Hospital, KEM Hospital, Nair Hospital, Wockhardt Hospital etc. and many more for the treatment of such children. Abhilasha Foundation has financially supported underprivileged children for their critical medical surgeries and has saved more than 50 lives.

We provide them facilities such as education, fulfilling their basic requirements and to make them a better citizen to contribute their support for the welfare of our nation. We support children suffering from issues such as maltreatment, child labour, human trafficking, HIV/AIDS, severe health issues, homeless and impoverishment.

Women Empowerment

Few of the underprivileged young students who could not afford their fees for their education are as follows :



Master Pradeep Ravindra Tiwari did his 12th and he wanted to join in the shipping industry that was his dream. But there was nobody to guide him, nor helped him in this sector. His father worked as a watchman and could not afford to fulfill his dream. Abhilasha Foundation guided him and financially supported him for pre sea training at T S Rahman "Converted Pradeep's desires into reality". This young boy joined a renowned shipping company and is very happy to achieve his goal.

Master Puran Singh Yadav a Nepal earthquake victim who had lost everything in the massive earthquake. His family migrated to Mumbai for their livelihood and he was pursuing his engineering from Thakur College of Engineering and Technology, Kandivali - Mumbai . He lost his father and his mother could not afford the fees for his education. Thakur College Principal sent him to Abhilasha Foundation for scholarship for his first year engineering. Now he is in IIIrd year of his engineering and scored 80% in his entire academic session. We thank Indiabulls for supporting Master Puran Singh for his scholarship. Abhilasha Foundation 'Converted Puran Singh Yadav's "desires into reality".



Ms. Pooja Amle, is doing her B.Com and her brother Mast. Akash Amle studying in 9th std. were not able to pay their fees. They lost their father and their mother is a domestic servant. Abhilasha Foundation supported financially by giving them the fees so that they can continue their education.



Mr. Kunal Jaydeepsinh Parmar is doing his Engineering from Sardar Vallabhai Patel Institute of Technology, Valsad, Gujarat. He was not able to pay his college fees. His father is an alcoholic and his mother works as a sales women in one of the boutiques. He has one younger brother who is also studying. Abhilasha Foundation supported financially by giving him the college fees so that he can continue his education.



Megha Gautam Kapadne a 7th standard student and Mayuresh Gautam Kapadne a 2nd standard student studying in Jivan Jyot Educational Society's, Virar both of them are very bright students. Their father lost his job and he is now jobless and their mother is working in a private firm and taking care of the whole family. It was very difficult for her to teach both the children in an English medium and they were not able to give the fees. But both the parents were determined that they will teach their children in an English medium school. Abhilasha Foundation supported financially by giving them the school fees so that they can continue their school education.

MEDICAL SUPPORT PROGRAMME FOR BPL CHILDREN



True Life Stories of children who had undergone Critical Medical Surgeries and got a New Lease of Life

Name : Baby Kanishka Ganpat Gholap
 Age : 4 month old baby girl
 Siblings : 3 Sisters
 Occupation of the father : Farmer
 Occupation of the mother : House wife



Case History : Baby Kanishka Ganpat Gholap is 4 months old baby girl suffering from congenital acyanotic heart disease with large muscular ventricular septal defect and large artial septal defect and she had to undergo VSD as early as possible. She was always falling sick and she was becoming very weak. Her parents were worried and were treating her with the local doctor in Pune. Doctors informed them that Baby Kanishka Ganpat Gholap has to undergo VSD closure. Due to their financial condition they could not operate this 4 month old baby girl. Her health started deteriorating and they took her to SevenHills Hospital. Doctors in SevenHills Hospital informed them that she requires an early total correction of the heart soon as her condition is deteriorating day by day and she is very weak. The approximate cost of the operation was Rs. 2,00,000/-.

Family Background : Her father works as a farmer in Pune. He earns only Rs. 3000/- per month. Since, his entire family and parents are dependent on him, he naturally is not in a position to bear the cost of the treatment of Baby Kanishka Ganpat Gholap for her urgent open heart surgery. Thanks to the timely intervention of Abhilasha Foundation and she was financially supported for her Open Heart Surgery on May 16th, 2015 at Seven Hills Hospital.

Name : Master Azhar Salim Shaikh
 Age : 2 Years Old
 Siblings : One younger sister
 Occupation of the father : Butcher



Case History: Master Azhar Salim Shaikh is a 2 year old boy and needed to undergo VSD closure (A Ventricular Septal Defect is a heart malformation present at birth) and ASD closure (Atrial Septal Defect) and reconstruction of the left Atrium as early as possible. Since birth they had been taking this child to KEM hospital for treatment and they could not afford for his open heart surgery. Then they went to SevenHills Hospitals and doctors informed them that Master Azhar Salim Shaikh is suffering from a complex congenital Heart Disease. Due to their financial condition they could not operate Master Azhar Salim Shaikh. His health started deteriorating day by day and they took him to SevenHills Hospital. Doctors in Seven Hills Hospital informed them that he required an urgent early Open Heart Surgery. The approximate cost of the surgery was Rs. 2,53,000/-.



Family Background: His father works as a Butcher and his mother is a house wife and they stay in Kalyan. His father earns only Rs. 1500/- per month. Since, his entire family and parents are dependent on him, he naturally is not in a position to bear the cost of the treatment of Master Azhar Salim Shaikh. Thanks to the timely intervention of Abhilasha Foundation and he was financially supported for his Open Heart Surgery on August 8th, 2015 at SevenHills Hospital, Andheri, Mumbai.

Name : Govind Gupta
Age : 15 years old boy
Siblings : 4 brothers
Occupation of the father : Farmer
Occupation of the mother : Housewife



Case History: Master Govind Gupta is 15 years old boy and needed to undergo chemotherapy who was diagnosed with Ewing's Sarcoma - Cancer. (Ewing's sarcoma is a malignant small round blue cell tumor. It started from the leg and now it has been spreading all over the body. His health started deteriorating and the doctors at P D Hinduja National Hospital & Medical Research Centre advised him to go for chemotherapy as early as possible. The approximate cost of the treatment was Rs. 7,00,000/-.

Family Background: His father works as a Farmer and his mother is a house wife and they stay in Gorakhpur. His father earns only Rs. 3500/- per month. Since, his entire family and parents are dependent on him, he naturally is not in a position to bear the cost of the treatment of Master Govind Gupta. Thanks to the timely intervention of Abhilasha Foundation and he was financially supported for his Cancer treatment from September, 2015 at P D Hinduja Hospital and has already undergone chemotherapy.

Name : Baby Aaliya Sayyad
Age : 6 months old baby Girl
Siblings : One brother
Occupation of the father : Carpenter
Occupation of the mother : Housewife



Case History: Baby Aaliya Sayyad is a 6 months old baby girl and she needed to undergo VSD closure (A Ventricular Septal Defect is a heart malformation present at birth). Since birth they had been going to Wadia hospital for treatment and then she was shifted to Kokilaben Dhirubhai Ambani Hospital and Medical Research Institute for her surgery. Due to their financial condition they could not operate Baby Aaliya Sayyad and her health started deteriorating day by day. Doctors in Kokilaben Dhirubhai Ambani Hospital informed them that she required an urgent early Open Heart Surgery. The approximate cost of the surgery was Rs. 1,95,000/-.

Family Background: Her father works as a Carpenter and now he is mentally sick due to his daughter's sickness. Her mother is a house wife and they stay in Mumbai. Her father earns only

Rs. 5000/- per month. Since the entire family and parents are dependent on him, he naturally is not in a position to bear the cost of the treatment of Baby Aaliya Sayyad. Thanks to the timely intervention of Abhilasha Foundation and she was financially supported for her Open Heart Surgery and was operated on 23rd October, 2015 at Kokilaben Dhirubhai Ambani Hospital.

Name : Baby Madhura Sharad Naikdhure
Age : 4 years and 2 months
Sibling : One younger brother
Occupation of the father : Farmer
Occupation of the mother : House wife



Case History: Baby Madhura Sharad Naikdhure is a 4 year 2 months old baby girl and needed to undergo an early elective total correction surgery of VSD closure. Due to their financial condition they could not operate this baby girl. Her health started deteriorating and they took her to SevenHills Hospital. Hence, doctors in SevenHills Hospital informed them that she requires an early open heart surgery. The approximate cost of the surgery was Rs. 2,63,000/-.

Family Background: Her father works as a farmer and mother is a house wife in Sindhudurg. He earns only Rs. 2125/- per month. Since, his entire family and parents are dependent on him, he naturally is not in a position to bear the cost of the treatment of Baby Madhura Naikdhure. Thanks to the timely intervention of Abhilasha Foundation and she was financially supported for her Open Heart Surgery on July 8th, 2015 at Seven Hills Hospital.

Name : Baby Pranjal U Mali
Age : 2 years and 8 months old
Occupation of the father : Vegetable Vendor
Occupation of the mother : House wife



Case History: Baby Pranjal U Mali who is 2 years and 8 months old baby girl needed to undergo PDA Device Closure/Ligation (PDA). Due to their financial condition they could not operate this baby girl. Her health started deteriorating and they took her to SevenHills Hospital. Hence, doctors in SevenHills Hospital informed them that she requires early surgery. The approximate cost of the surgery was Rs. 87,000/- for PDA closure.

Family Background: Her father is a vegetable vendor and mother is a housewife hailing from Nandurbar, Maharashtra. He earns only Rs. 2000/- per month. Since, his entire family and parents are dependent on him, he naturally is not in a position to bear the cost of the treatment of Baby Pranjal U Mali. Thanks to the timely intervention of Abhilasha Foundation and she was financially supported for her Open Heart Surgery on July 25th, 2015 at SevenHills Hospital.



Name : Baby Tanu Borse
Age : 6 year old
Siblings : One younger brother
Occupation of the father : Labourer
Occupation of the mother : Housewife



Case History: Baby Tanu Borse is a 6 year old baby girl who is suffering from congenital heart disease. Due to their financial condition they could not operate Baby Tanu Borse. Her health started deteriorating day by day and they took her to Wockhardt Hospital. Doctors in Wockhardt Hospital informed them that she requires an urgent early Open Heart Surgery. The approximate cost of the surgery was Rs. 3,00,000/- for an Open Heart Surgery.

Family Background: Her father works as a labourer in a factory and her mother is a house wife and they stay in Nashik. Her father earns only Rs. 8069/- per month. Since, his entire family and parents are dependent on him, he naturally is not in a position to bear the cost of the treatment of Baby Tanu Borse. Thanks to the timely intervention of Abhilasha Foundation and she was financially supported for her Open Heart Surgery on 2nd November, 2015 at Wockhardt Hospital.

Name : Master Shivshant Biradar

Occupation of the father : Working in a matth as Supervisor
Occupation of the mother : House wife



Case History: Master Shivshant Biradar is one year old boy and needed to undergo a complex Open Heart Surgery - TOF with hypoplastic PA'S Tetralogy of Fallot. Due to their financial condition they could not operate Master Shivshant Biradar. His health started deteriorating day by day and they took him to Sir H N Hospital and Research Centre, Mumbai. Doctors informed them that he requires an urgent Open Heart Surgery as early as possible. The approximate cost of the surgery was Rs. 2,50,000/-.

Family Background: His father works as a Supervisor in a Matth and his mother is a house wife and they stay in Kolhapur. His father earns only Rs. 4000/- per month. Since, his entire family and parents are dependent on him, he naturally is not in a position to bear the cost of the treatment of Master Shivshant Biradar. Thanks to the timely intervention of Abhilasha Foundation and he was financially supported for his Open Heart Surgery and was successfully operated on December 17th, 2015 at Sir H N Hospital and Research Centre, Mumbai.

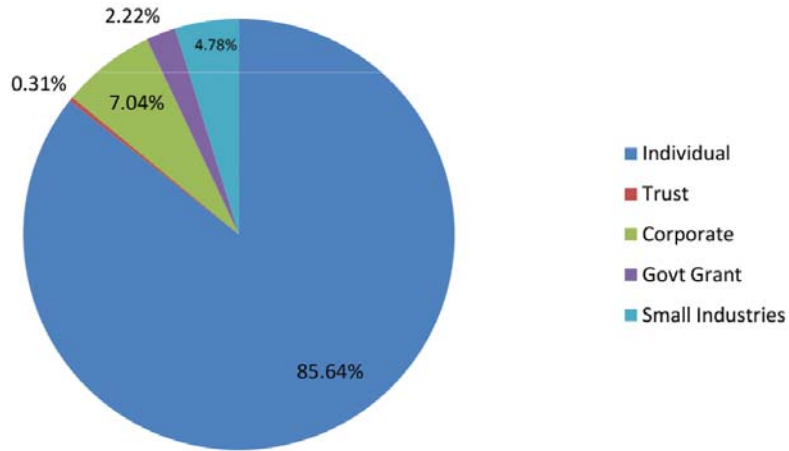

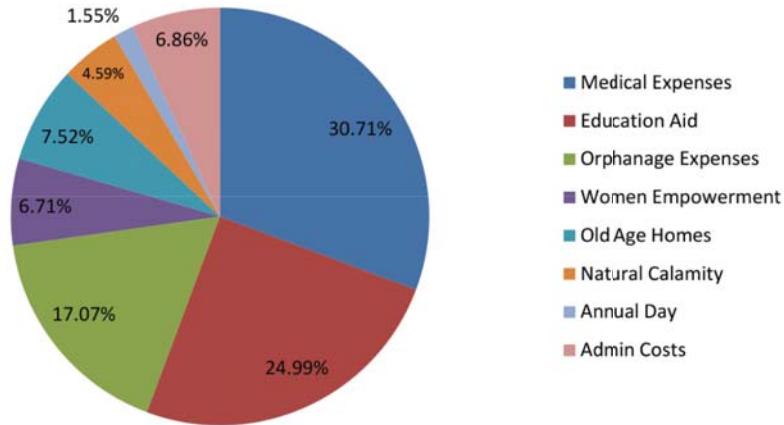

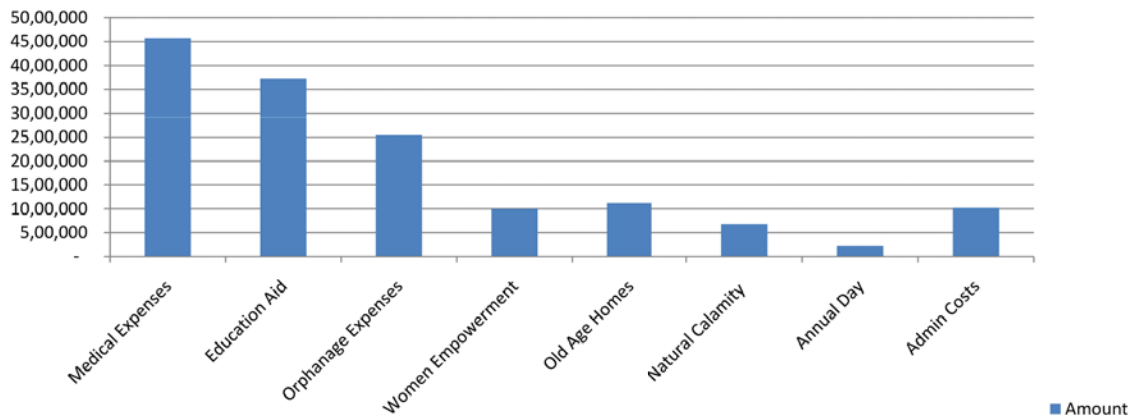
Details of Donations and Collection

YOUTH DUPED OF RS 4 LAKH WITH LURE OF OVERSEAS JOB; 3 HELD IN NASHIK

A 22-year-old youth from Nashik was allegedly duped of over Rs. 4 lakh by three persons who lured him with a job offer abroad and then used the victim's loan which was returned.

The accused - Shaikh Bushan Sharany Singh (23), Chivhanuram alias Manojkumar Singh (23) and Abhilash Konde (23) - have been arrested in Maharashtra. They said.

The victim, Bhushan Rajendra Yadav, from Panchsari in Nashik, was lured by job when he heard of the offer on overseas recruitment agency of Kaps in Thane.

Shaikh Bushan, the company director, allegedly promised him a job with a monthly stipend of Rs. 150,000 per month. He was asked to pay Rs. 3.30 lakh for it and to bear his travel expenses. The victim's wife said she loaned in Nashik and also collected loan from relatives and friends.

The youth allegedly deposited Rs. 2 lakh in the Bangalore bank account of one Arvind Dagar on July 27, 2015, based on instructions from Shaikh Bushan, police said.

Konde provided fake name documents, including a new travel and visa and he paid on September 10th amount of Rs. 60,000 to the agent in Thane when he hands them. He was told that the passport job was completed and he would get the job once he hands them, police said.

On getting a fully signed contract, the victim met two agents and handed them USD 1,200 for Turkey passport. However, instead of getting a job in the passport, they allegedly took Yadav to a tiny room in Bawdar and dumped him along with 25 others who had been duped of Rs. four lakh various parts of India, in release issued by Thane police crime branch.

Yadav was allegedly given a standard food for one month and after being lured, he was put to work in a filling boiler for which he was not paid for two months, police said.

Later, Yadav managed to escape from there. He came to India in February this year and lodged a complaint with Thane police on July 20. The crime branch of Thane police took up probe in the case and subsequently arrested Shaikh Bushan from Lihogangar on July 31. The main accused Chivhanuram from his native place of Bargarh in Orissa was arrested, and Konde from Pune on August 16.
